Professor Martin Banks is the director of the Visual Space Perception Laboratory at UC Berkely, where he is a full professor of Optometry, Vision Science, Psychology, Bioengineering, and Neuroscience. He is visiting Ohio State to discuss his research in collaboration with Dr. Ron Li and the NASA Glenn Research Center on “Enhancement of Spatial Orientation Capability of Astronauts on the Lunar Surface” in support of future landed NASA missions on the Moon. Professor Banks has received numerous awards including the McCandless Award from the American Psychological Association and the Koffka Medal from Giessen University. He is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science; Fellow of the American Psychological Society; Fellow of the Institute for Advanced Study, Durham University; and Fellow of the Center for the Advanced Study of Behavioral Sciences.
